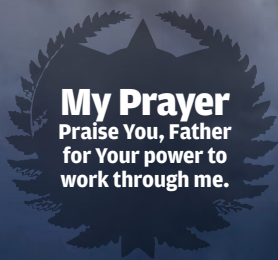
the love of Christ with those around you, remember you can only accomplish it with the power of the Holy Spirit at work in you.

Your main job as a Christian is sharing the good news with those around you.

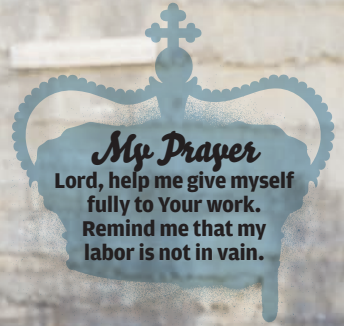
**Who around you needs to hear? Is it a family member, a friend, or a neighbor?**

## Fully Give
